Regulations for volunteers

Regulations:

1. An Europa Cup 2020 volunteer can be anyone who turns 18 on latest June 1, 2020. We do not accept minors for voluntary work.
2. We accept of a candidate for a volunteer by sending an email with a voluntary work agreement. A hard copy of the agreement will be signed at Europa Cup but is applicable – if you want to quit, do let us know by email.
3. A voluntary work agreement specifies the conditions, especially timing and your privileges. The agreements differ from one another depending on which team you have been appointed to.
4. Volunteer is obliged to participate in the organizational meeting to take part on Tue, June 2, 2020 or Wed, June 3, 2020 depending on the team.
5. Volunteer is obliged to read email messages sent by the Organizer.
6. Volunteer is obliged to stay in Katowice until Mon June 8, 2020 until 20.00 hrs. and participate in the common tidying up and disassembly after Europa Cup 2020.
7. Apart from working hours, a volunteer can participate in the European Championship in Floristry free of charge in 4 shows scheduled for Fri and seminars planned for Sat.
8. Volunteer is not granted a free access to either the Masters of Masters Show or the Grand Gala Night.
9. Volunteer will be invited to the Afterparty.
10. Every day a volunteer will receive a meal, water and other drinks.
11. All the volunteers will be insured against dangerous accidents during their voluntary work.
12. We will not refund volunteers travelling expenses or accommodation. In some justified cases, we can support the volunteers in their search for accommodation.
13. A volunteer should be friendly, ethical and should not give any reason for a negative opinion about himself/herself.
14. By sending back the questionnaire a volunteer consents to the processing to his/her personal information.
15. As an adult and a person capable of legal actions by sending the questionnaire you agree to publish your effigy (face, outfit, behavior, voice, verbal expression, way of expressing your thoughts) by SFP, which can be recorded as photographs and audio-visual recordings of the Event and other events with the participation of SFP.
16. The consent described above is granted free of any charges for an unlimited time and repetitions. The consent includes recording, editing, processing, copying materials of an effigy and broadcasting them by any medium (each form of broadcasting picture and sound), in accordance with the goal and activities by SFP aimed at promoting the organization and its activities. Moreover, the Association is authorized to grant further consent to their parties (people, organizational units) to promote, use and spread the information about Europa Cup. Furthermore, I declare that the use of effigy as per the present consent does not harm anyone's personal rights and laws.

Rules for the processing of personal data

We inform that pursuant to art 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), later referred to as GDPR:

1. The administrator of your personal data is the Polish Florist Association based in Turza Śląska, ul. Wodziaławska 37a, e-mail: stowarzyszenie@floryscipolscy.pl
2. Your personal data will be processed to create a database of volunteers for preparation and organisation of the European Florist Championship know as Europa Cup as well as to insure the volunteers.
3. For reasons of safety of participants of Europa Cup, your personal data can be verified.
4. Your personal data will be processed until 10 June 2020 to organise Europa Cup and after 10 June 2020, they will be processed in compliance with archiving regulations.
5. You have the right to access your personal data, rectify your data, erase your personal data, restrict processing of your personal data and you have the right to object to processing your personal data.
6. You have the right to withdraw consent at any time without any effect on the lawfulness of processing being made on the basis of the consent given before its withdrawal.
7. You have the right to lodge a complaint to a Supervisory Authority if you decide that the processing of your personal data has breached the regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 of on the protection of personal data under to Art. 77.
8. Providing your personal data is voluntary however it is necessary for the recruitment process.
